

GOUDRIAAN GENERAL CEMETERY

Goudriaan is a village lying 30 kilometres (18\frac{3}{4}\) miles) outh-south-west of Utrecht, 40 kilometres (25 miles) ast of Rotterdam and 17 kilometres (about 10\frac{1}{2}\) miles) forth-north-west of Gorinchem. The nearest railway tation and hotels are at Gorinchem, and there is a ocal bus service.

The cemetery is in the centre of the village, partly round the church. In the north-eastern corner are the raves of 5 airmen, three from the United Kingdom and two from Canada. A private memorial to these men

tands in the centre of the small plot.

Hardinxveld is 15 kilometres (about 9½ miles) east of Dordrecht and rather less west of Gorinchem, and is 12 kilometres (26¼ miles) north-north-east of Breda. Boven (Upper) Hardinxveld is part of the village and ies strung out along the north bank of the river Waal. The nearest railway station and hotels are at Gorinchem; there is limited accommodation in the village and a local out service.

The cemetery is half a mile east of the church, on the north side of the dyke road to Gorinchem. The British grave is in the north-eastern part, close to the eastern

oundary hedge.

Heicop, a village in the commune of Hei-en-Boeicop, is 24 kilometres (15 miles) south of Utrecht and 49 kilometres (about 28 miles) east of Rotterdam. The nearest railway station is Leerdam, about 5 miles to the south. There is a local bus service, and limited accommodation is available.

The cemetery is in the centre of the village, on the north side of the road to Leerdam. In the north-western corner are the graves of 6 airmen, five from the United

Kingdom and one from Canada.
